

Welcome to Depalpur City

Depalpur is a City in Okara district of the Punjab and the Depalpur Tehsil, assumed to be the largest tehsil of Pakistan. The City is notable for being the site of several battles in the thirteenth and fourteenth centuries and it is also associated with the history of the Bhatti clan. According to the historian Abnashi Chander Das "AC DAS", the original name of this city was "Siri Puria" or "Siri Nagar" after the elder brother of Raja Salvanhan of Sialkot (who was the explorer of Sialkot) Raja Deva Pahla renamed Depalpur after his beloved son Raja Depa . Raja Depa built a fort here and named it as "Depapur" which was later refined as "Depalpur".

There are several prominent places of interests are existing in Depalpur which are mentioned as Pakpattan gate, Jami Masjid, Hujra Shah Muqem etc. Important features of the town are listed below:
